Input Devices (A2.1.1)

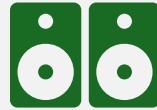
- Used to enter data into a computer.
- Examples include keyboards, mice, scanners, and cameras.
- Essential for user interaction with digital devices.



Output Devices (A2.1.2)



Display or present information from a computer.



Examples include monitors, printers, and speakers.

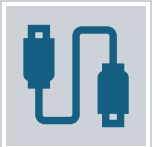


Enable users to view or hear processed data.

Storage Devices (A2.1.3)



Used to store data for short or long term.



Examples include hard drives, SSDs, and USB sticks.



Essential for saving and retrieving files.
